

## - Gasicgrey /fruit cake

## Finished Size: 72"x 90"

## Fabric Requirements

Main Wedges: 23/4 yards Assorted Wedges:
$9 " x 22$ each of 20 prints Background:
$11 / 4$ yards each of 5 prints
Binding: $\quad 7 / 8$ yard
Backing: $\quad 51 / 2$ yards

## Cutting

## Hint: Heavily spray starch the fabrics before cutting for more stability.

Cutting is for raw edge appliqué.

## Main Wedges:

Cut 10-9"x WOF strips subcut 20-9"x 22 " strips use template C to cut 100 wedges See diagram for layout

## Assorted Wedges:

from each of 20 prints use template C to cut 5 wedges See diagram for layout
Background:
from each of 5 backgrounds cut 2-20"x WOF strips
subcut $4-20 " \times 20$ " squares
Binding:
Cut $9-21 / 2$ "x WOF strips

## Quilter Basics

Read instructions before beginning a project. All instructions include a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. $22^{\prime \prime}$ measurement is approximate.
WOF-approximately 40".

## Construdtion

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The instructions are written for raw edge appliqué.

1$16^{\prime \prime}$ Circle from Square: Trace Template A on template plastic, combining 4 sections to form a $16^{\prime \prime}$ circle. Mark the center of the circle on the template. Fold a 20 " Background square in half twice to find center. Center and trace the circle on an 20" background square and carefully cut on the drawn line. Set aside circle for Step 2. Repeat for a total of 20 Background blocks, 4 from each of the 5 Backgrounds.


Center template and cut from square.


Make 20.

6" Center Circle: Trace Template B on template plastic, combining 4 sections to form a 6 " circle. Trace the circle on the Background circles left over from Step 1 and cut out. Cut a total of 20-6" circles, 4 from each of the 5 Backgrounds.


## Repeat Step 3 to make 20 Main Blocks. The instructions are for raw edge appliqué.

Main Block: (A) Sew 5 Main wedges and 5 wedges of another print together, alternating the wedges. Press the seams in one direction.
(B) Center a 6 " Center Circle on the Wedge. Pin in place. The $6 "$ circle will overlap the Wedge by about $1 / 22^{\prime \prime}$. Blanket or zig zag stitch the circle to the wedge. (Option: cut edge using decorative scissors before stitching or add rick rack) (C) Center the Background square that matches the 6" Circle on the Wedge/Circle. There will be a $1 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ overlap. Pin in place. Blanket or zig zag stitch. (Option: cut edge using decorative scissors before stitching or add rick rack) (D) Trim the Main Block to measure $181 / 2$ "x $181 / 2$ " with seams.
Repeat to make 20 Main Blocks.

Combine wedges.

Trim to $181 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ square with seams.

Combine 5 rows of 4 blocks each. Press the rows in opposite directions. Join the rows.

Join 9-21/2"xWOF Binding strips. Layer, quilt and bind. ENJOY!
